**Topic:**                   **Commercial Driver’s License Tuition Adjustment**

**Presentation:**

The College began pursuing a new provider for its Commercial Driver’s License (CDL) program in December of 2020. In consulting with multiple providers, the administration determined that Midwest Safe Driver provided the best value, instruction, and personnel to serve our students. As a result, Sauk has been able to secure a rate that increases its revenue stream while decreasing the costs to students. The proposed rate of tuition for CDL training would decrease from \$4,520 to \$4,200 per student. As part of this new partnership, the College will also be able to pursue its own trailer to market throughout the community.

**Recommendation:**

The administration recommends the Board approve the CDL tuition adjustment for the remainder of FY21 and FY22 as presented.
