Presentation:

The administration has begun a new process of reviewing all Board policies annually. As a part of this review, minor clarifying edits are being recommended for the following policies:

301.01 Budgeting, Purchasing, Accounting, and Auditing Finance Procedures

Budgeting, purchasing, accounting, and auditing Finance procedures shall be established and conducted according to generally accepted accounting practices as prescribed by the Administrative Rules of the Illinois Community College Board (Ill. Admin. Code tit. 23, § 1501.501 et seq.) by other cognizant government agencies, and by such statutes or requirements as may be applicable to the expenditure of public or grant funds.

501.01 Academic Programs and Requirements

The academic programs and requirements for the addition or deletion of any certificate or degree shall be authorized by vote of the Board of Trustees upon recommendation from the President and will be subject to additional approval procedures required by <u>Part 1501 of the Illinois Public</u> <u>Community College Act</u>, the <u>Administrative Rules of the</u> Illinois Community College Board, the <u>Illinois</u> Board of Higher Education, and other <u>cognizant pertinent</u> regulatory agencies.

Recommendation:

The administration recommends the Board approve edits to Board Policies 301.01 Budgeting, Purchasing, Accounting, and Auditing Procedures and 501.01 Academic Programs and Requirements as presented for a second reading.
