## **Presentation:**

The exterior windows and doors in the Dillon Mall are original to the building and are in need of replacement. Over time, these structures have deteriorated, resulting in drafts, leaks, and reduced insulation, which increase energy costs and create an uncomfortable environment for students and staff. Additionally, Door #25, which provides access to the new West Mall Plaza, needs to be upgraded to an ADA-compliant automatic opener to meet modern accessibility standards. Replacing these windows and doors will enhance energy efficiency while creating a safer, more inclusive, and comfortable environment for the entire college community.
