

Transfer Plan



Elementary Education

- This is a degree plan that leads to a Bachelor of Science in Education (B.S. Ed.) degree in Elementary Education at WIU. Students will fill out applications for both schools, consult the advisors and catalogs from both schools for specifics. This completion guide is designed to earn a bachelors in Education taking courses at both Sauk Valley Community College (SVCC) and Western Illinois University (WIU). This guide assumes students have met all course prerequisites required by SVCC and admission requirements for WIU.
- Upon completion of the first two years' requirements at SVCC, students will receive an Associate of Arts
 (A.A.) degree. Students will be required to complete the Elementary Education core requirements at WIU,
 and upon completion of the curriculum/licensure requirements students will receive the B.S. Ed. degree
 with a major in Elementary Education. In general, a minimum of 64 semester hours (s.h.) will be taken at
 SVCC at SVCC tuition rates and a minimum of 60 s.h. from WIU at WIU tuition rates.
- Students must achieve a 2.5 GPA in order to be accepted into and continue in WIU Elementary Education Major. These grade point averages must be maintained for graduation as an Elementary Education major.

Notes for WIU:

- A minimum of 42 upper-division hours (numbered 300 and above) are required from a 4-year institution
- A minimum of 60 hours is required from a 4-year institution
- A minimum GPA of 2.5 will be required overall, both cumulative and major, for admittance and continuation in the Teacher Education Program.
- Complete at least 30 hours while in residence at WIU, at least 15 of which must be taken in the year prior to graduation.
